



# Attitude Overdrive



## Overview

Students will watch the NSTeens video "Attitude Overdrive" and discuss what to do when they encounter "griefers" while playing games online. They will make a fact wheel to remind them how to deal with griefers.



# Materials / Preparation

- Computer lab or computer hooked up to an LCD projector
- Video "Attitude Overdrive"
- Attachment 1 "How I Deal with Griefers" fact wheel
- Paper fasteners (1 per child)
- Chalkboard/whiteboard



## 30 minutes



### Introduction -

Ask your students:

Do any of you play online games? Do you ever talk to other people while gaming online? What kind of conversations do you have?

#### Discuss.

Then tell them: Sometimes, people are mean or rude in online games. Those people are called "griefers" because they try to ruin your game. We're going to learn more about it in this video.



## Activity

Show "Attitude Overdrive." Ask your students: How did NSTeens characters Becks and CL deal with the griefer? (They blocked him.) Then have the class discuss other ways to deal with griefers:

- Ignore them
- Block or mute them
- Save the messages to show a trusted adult
- Delete existing accounts and set-up new ones
- Report griefing to the gaming service or website
- Talk to a trusted adult about the incident
- Don't respond in anger and become a griefer yourself

Designate a student to write the class's answers on a chalkboard/whiteboard.

Give each student 1 paper fastener and a copy of the "How I Deal with Griefers" fact wheel (attachment 1). Tell them to choose four ways they will use to deal with griefers while gaming and construct a fact wheel. Students may share their completed wheels with the class.



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Explain to students that other than not becoming griefers themselves, there are other rules they should follow when gaming online. Ask them to write a paragraph responding to the following scenarios:

What should you do if another gamer



asks for personal information, like your account password? makes you feel uncomfortable?
offers you a deal that sounds too good to be true?
asks to meet you in person?



# HOW I DEAL WITH GRIEFERS FACT WHEEL

This fact wheel will help you remember what to do when you meet a griefer in an online game.
